The California Air Resources Board (ARB/Board) staff invites you to participate in our fourth public workshop to discuss development of regulations for ocean-going vessel (OGV) main engines and auxiliary boilers. As part of the Diesel Risk Reduction Plan and Goods Movement Plan efforts, ARB staff is developing this regulation to reduce emissions of diesel and other forms of particulate matter, oxides of nitrogen, and oxides of sulfur emissions from OGV main engines and auxiliary boilers by limiting the sulfur content of the fuel used.
