

Executive Order G-893

WHEREAS, on June 10, 1993, the Air Resources Board conducted a public hearing to consider the proposed amendment of regulations regarding California exhaust emission standards and test procedures for 1985 and subsequent model heavy-duty diesel engines and vehicles, to specify standards for 1994 and subsequent urban bus engines;

WHEREAS, following the public hearing, the Board adopted Resolution 93-46, in which the Board approved amendment of sections 1956.8, 1965, 2112 and the applicable test procedures, Title 13, California Code of Regulations (CCR), as set forth in Attachment A thereto;

WHEREAS, Resolution 93-46 directed the Executive Officer to adopt the regulations, after making them available to the public for a period of 15 days, provided that the Executive Officer shall consider such written comments regarding the changes in the regulations as originally proposed as may be submitted during this period, shall make such modifications as may be appropriate in light of the comments received, and shall present the regulations to the Board for further consideration if he determines that this is warranted;

WHEREAS, the approved regulations were available for public comment for a period of 18 days, commencing August 20, 1993 and ending September 7, 1993, with the changes to the originally proposed text clearly indicated, in accordance with the provisions of Title 1, CCR, section 44;


WHEREAS, no written comments were received during this 18-day comment period; and

WHEREAS, the reporting requirements of the approved regulations which apply to small businesses are necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the people of the state.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the recitals and findings contained in Resolution 93-46 are incorporated herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that sections 1956.8, 1965, 2112 and the applicable test procedures are amended as set forth in Attachment 1 hereto.
