- SUBJECT: AIR RESOURCES BOARD TEXT ERROR OAL REGULATORY FILE NUMBER: 2011-1028-0S; LARGE SPARK IGNITION REGULATION

ARB has discovered that an existing definition "Nut hullers and processors" for the LSI Fleet Regulation (Title 13, Section 2775(d)) was unintentionally dropped from the text originally submitted to OAL on October 28, 2011. It was mistakenly removed from the published text and ARB wishes to correct this oversight by placing it back in the text submitted to Secretary of State and the publisher at your earliest convenience.

Attached, please find a copy of the corrected pages of the Final Regulation Order for the "Amendments to the LSI Fleet Regulation," section 2775 of title 13, CCR. This text contains the language that was previously inadvertently omitted from the Secretary of State filing on December 14, 2011 (the definition of "Nut hullers and processors).
