The California Air Resources Board (ARB) has adopted an optional regulation and associated certification procedures for new light-duty

engines for use in specially constructed vehicles (SPCNS, such as kit cars). The regulation and procedures ensure that certified engine packages, when placed into any SPCNS, meet new vehicle emission standards, and are

able to meet Smog Check requirements.

Executive Order R-12-011 Dated: September 27, 2012

This notice is to advise that ARB, as the lead agency, has adopted the above described regulatory action on September 27, 2012, and has determined that the regulatory action will not have a significant adverse effect on the environment (see attached Executive Order R-12-011).
