The Air Resources Board (Board) proposed this action to amend sections 2030 and 2031 of title 13 of the California Code of Regulations in response to industry requests to amend regulations pertaining to conversion of vehicles or engines to operate on alternative fuels by streamlining the procedures for acquiring certification of alternative fuel conversion systems so they are less time consuming and less costly. The proposed action also amends an existing incorporated Board test procedure pertaining to alternative fuel retrofit systems so that it applies only to 1993 through 2003 model year vehicles and engines, and adopts a new incorporated Board test procedure to apply to alternative fuel retrofit systems from 2004 through 2017 model year vehicles and engines. One of the objectives of this action was to align California regulations on alternative fuel retrofit systems with the recent amendments to the federal regulations without compromising existing California emission standards, thus enabling manufacturers to use much of the data that they must provide the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to also obtain approval by the Board.

OAL approves this regulatory action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code. This regulatory action becomes effective on 9/15/2014.


