**Executive Order R-15-005**

*Relating to New and Amended Certification Procedures for Vapor Recovery Systems  
at Gasoline Dispensing Facilities*

WHEREAS, on April 23, 2015, the Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) conducted a public hearing to consider the proposed amendments to Certification Procedures for Vapor Recovery Systems at Gasoline Dispensing Facilities: Aboveground Storage Tanks and Enhanced Conventional Nozzles, as set forth in Appendix A to the Initial Statement of Reasons released to the public on March 3, 2015;

WHEREAS, the environmental analysis prepared under ARB's regulatory program certified under Public Resources Code section 21080.5 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA; California Code of Regulations, Title 14, section 15251(d)) in the Staff Report concluded that the amendments will not result in any significant adverse impacts on the environment;

WHEREAS, two written comments unrelated to the proposed rulemaking action were received during the initial 45-day comment period, and those comments were considered by the Executive Officer;

WHEREAS, following the public hearing, the Board adopted Resolution 15-8 in which the Board approved for adoption amendments to Sections 94010, 94011, and 94016; and new Section 94017, Title 17 California Code of Regulations, as set forth in Attachment A and Attachment B of the resolution;

WHEREAS, Resolution 15-8 directed the Executive Officer to make any additional conforming modifications deemed appropriate available for public comment, with any additional supporting documents and information, for a period of at least 15 days; to consider written comments submitted during the public review period; and to present the regulation to the Board for further consideration if warranted, or if no conforming modifications are appropriate, to take final action to adopt the regulation;

WHEREAS, no additional conforming modifications have been made to the proposed amendments.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the recitals and findings contained in Resolution 15-8 are incorporated herein.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the amendments to sections 94010, 94011, 94016, and new section 94017, Title 17 California Code of Regulations, as set forth in Attachment 1 to this order, which incorporate by reference the following documents: D-200 - "Definitions for Vapor Recovery Procedures," as set forth in Attachment 2 to this order, CP-201 - "Certification Procedure for Vapor Recovery Systems at Gasoline Dispensing Facilities," as set forth in Attachment 3 to this order, CP-206 - "Certification Procedure for Vapor Recovery Systems at Gasoline Dispensing Facilities Using Aboveground Storage Tanks," as set forth in Attachment 4 to this order, and CP-207 - "Certification Procedure for Enhanced Conventional (ECO) Nozzles and Low Permeation Conventional Hoses for Use at Gasoline Dispensing Facilities," as set forth in Attachment 5 to this order, are adopted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the adopted regulatory text and incorporated certification procedures may be further revised with non-substantial or grammatical changes, which will be added to the rulemaking record and indicated as such.
