Regulation for the Reporting of Criteria Air Pollutants and Toxic Air Contaminants (Distributed at the December 14, 2018, Board hearing)

Topics Subject to Potential 15-Day Changes

This document provides an overview of the topics CARB staff now intends to propose for further public consideration as part of a subsequent 15-day comment period. This list is not exhaustive and does not include minor technical changes that may be proposed.

Staff will continue to coordinate with stakeholders in the development of the regulatory text. This list in no way limits CARB's authority to make other changes to the proposed regulatory amendments, consistent with the requirements of California law.

Applicability/Exclusions

CARB staff will propose modifications to the exclusion requirement language for natural gas distribution facilities for clarity in section 93401(b)(1)(C). The original intent of the requirement is unchanged.

CARB staff will propose modifications of the proposed regulation's Fourth Applicability Criterion to better satisfy the public health and air-quality reporting objectives of AB 197 and AB 617. These may include the introduction of thresholds for reporting based upon emissions quantity or toxicity, and may expand reporting to sources statewide above this threshold amount, in light of AB 617's ultimate focus on communities across the state, many of which may enter the program over time.

Definitions

CARB staff will propose updates to the definitions for "Facility" and "Natural gas distribution facility" in section 93402 of the proposed CTR Regulation, to clarify the original intent of the language pertaining to natural gas distribution facilities. Other minor revisions to definitions may also be made for clarity.

Emission Reporting Requirements

CARB staff will propose changes to the reporting requirements to clarify the intent of the text and to facilitate regulatory implementation.

Emission Report Contents

Based on comments received, staff will propose several clarifications to the emissions report content requirements in section 93404.

Enforcement Provisions

For clarity, CARB staff will propose some reorganization of elements of the enforcement text in section 93407 of the proposed CTR Regulation. CARB staff will also evaluate the enforcement text and potentially include further 15-day revisions based on comments received.
