The Office of Administrative Law is authorized to make the following substitutions, additions, deletions and other changes in connection with the above-referenced rulemaking:

- (1) Substitute the revised final regulation text (previously emailed) behind each copy of the Form 400 for filing with the Secretary of State and as the attachment to Executive Order R-07-006 in Tab 2 of the rulemaking file.
- (2) Add the enclosed revised Form 400 to each copy of the final regulation text for filing with the Secretary of State.
- (3) Substitute the enclosed revised and updated Certificate of Closure for the Rulemaking File at the beginning of the rulemaking file following the Table of Contents.
- (4) In the Notice of Postponement in Tab 8 of the rulemaking file, remove the two middle pages which are unrelated to this rulemaking. These two pages were inadvertently included in this copy of the notice and were not part of the notice as mailed and made available to the public.
- (5) Add to Tab 14 of the rulemaking file the following written public comments and written submissions related to oral testimony which were received during the 45-day comment period (through the time of the December 7, 2006 public hearing): MFASC-3 - additional attachments and photo submitted September 27, 2006; MFASC-4; BAAQMD-1; SCAQMD-1 – slides from September 28, 2006 oral testimony; SCAQMD-2 -- slides from September 28, 2006 oral testimony; Grana-1 -- written source test report from September 28, 2006 oral testimony; Wallerstein-2; Environmental Groups-2; and Cunningham-2.
