EXECUTIVE ORDER G-02-056

Relating to Public Hearing to Consider Adoption of Regulations for the Availability
of California Motor Vehicle Service Information

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2001, the Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) conducted a public hearing to consider proposed adoption Regulations for the Availability of California Motor Vehicle Service Information;

WHEREAS, following the public hearing on December 13, 2001, the Board adopted Resolution 01-55, in which the Board approved adoption of the following sections of title 13, California Code of Regulations, and the documents incorporated by reference therein: division 3, chapter 1, Motor Vehicle Pollution Control Devices; article 2, Approval of Motor Vehicle Pollution Control Devices (New Vehicles), section 1969, Motor Vehicle Service Information – 1994 and Subsequent Model Passenger Cars, Light-Duty and Medium-Duty Vehicles, and the incorporated “Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE) Recommended Practice J1930, May 1998” and draft “SAE J2534, Revision 5.2, September 2001.” Adoption of sections 60060.1 through 60060.34, title 17, California Code of Regulations (CCR): chapter 1, subchapter 1.25, article 2.5, Administrative Procedures for Review of Executive Officer Determinations Regarding Service Information for 1994 and Subsequent Model Year Vehicles, all as set forth in Attachment A and B thereto.

WHEREAS, in Resolution 01-55, the Board directed the Executive Officer to incorporate into the approved adoption the modifications described above, with such other conforming modifications as may be appropriate, and then to adopt the modified amendments, after making the modified regulatory language available for public comment for a period of 15 days, provided that the Executive Officer shall consider such written comments regarding the modified text as may be submitted during this period, shall make modifications as may be appropriate in light of the comments received, and shall present the regulations to the Board for further consideration if he determines that this is warranted;

WHEREAS, on March 29, 2002, the modified regulations, reflecting the amendments approved by the Board and other changes made to best reflect the intent of the Board at the hearing, were made available for public comment for a period of 15 days, with the changes to the originally proposed text clearly indicated, in accordance with the provisions of title 1, California Code of Regulations, section 44;

WHEREAS, a four written comments were received during the 15-day comment period and those comments have been considered by the Executive Officer; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the recitals and findings contained in Resolution 01-55 are incorporated by reference herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED in accordance with Resolution 01-55, that adoption of the following sections of title 13, California Code of Regulations, and the documents incorporated by reference therein: division 3, chapter 1, Motor Vehicle Pollution Control Devices; article 2, Approval of Motor Vehicle Pollution Control Devices (New Vehicles), section 1969, Motor Vehicle Service Information – 1994 and Subsequent Model Passenger Cars, Light-Duty and Medium-Duty Vehicles, and the incorporated “Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE) Recommended Practice J1930, May 1998” and draft “SAE J2534, Revision 5.2, September 2001.” Adoption of sections 60060.1 through 60060.34, title 17, California Code of Regulations (CCR): chapter 1, subchapter 1.25, article 2.5, Administrative Procedures for Review of Executive Officer Determinations Regarding Service Information for 1994 and Subsequent Model Year Vehicles are adopted as set forth in Attachment 1 and 2 hereto.
