

EXECUTIVE ORDER G-97-033

WHEREAS, on July 25, 1996, the Air Resources Board ("Board") conducted a public hearing to consider amendments to section 93300.5, Title 17, California Code of Regulations (CCR) and to the Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Program Emission Inventory Criteria and Guidelines Report (Guidelines Report) incorporated by reference therein;

WHEREAS, following the public hearing the Board adopted Resolution 96-41, in which the Board approved amendments to section 93300.5 and the Guidelines Report, including appendices, as set forth in Attachment A thereto;

WHEREAS, Resolution 96-41 directed the Executive Officer to adopt the regulations, after making any changes necessitated by the passage of pending legislation or clarification regarding district determinations and after making the modified language available for public comment for a period of 15 days, provided that the Executive Officer shall consider such written comments regarding the modifications as may be submitted during this period, shall make modifications as may be appropriate in light of the comments received, and shall present the regulations to the Board for further consideration if he determines that this is warranted;

WHEREAS, the Board further directed the Executive Officer to clarify and revise as appropriate the proposed Guidelines Report procedures regarding district determinations for identification or exemption of facilities, and the Executive Officer has made such appropriate revisions;

WHEREAS, the approved regulations were available to the public for a 15-day comment period, with changes to the originally proposed text clearly indicated, in accordance with the provisions of Title 1, CCR, section 44;


WHEREAS, all written comments received during the 15-day public comment period have been considered by the Executive Officer and do not require modification nor reconsideration by the Board of the approved regulations;

WHEREAS, the reporting requirements of the approved regulations which apply to small business are necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the people of the state.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the recitals and findings contained in Resolution 96-41 are incorporated herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that section 93300.5, Title 17, CCR, and the Emissions Inventory Criteria and Guidelines Report, including appendices, which is incorporated by reference therein, are amended as set forth in Attachment 1 hereto.
