NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING TO CONSIDER THE FUNDING GUIDELINES FOR AGENCIES THAT ADMINISTER CALIFORNIA CLIMATE INVESTMENTS

The Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) will conduct a public meeting at the time and place noted below to consider the Funding Guidelines for Agencies that Administer California Climate Investments.

This item will be considered at a two-day meeting of the Board, which will commence at 9:00 a.m., September 24, 2015, and will continue at 8:30 a.m., September 25, 2015. Please consult the agenda for the meeting, which will be available at least 10 days before September 24, 2015, to determine the day on which this item will be considered.

The Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund holds the State's portion of auction proceeds, generated by California's Cap-and-Trade Program. Each fiscal year, the Governor and Legislature determine which State agencies and programs will receive appropriations from this Fund to invest in projects that reduce greenhouse gases (California Climate Investments). State law requires ARB to develop guidance for all State agencies that receive appropriations from the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund, including guidance on reporting, quantification methods, and maximizing benefits to disadvantaged communities. Pursuant to the law, ARB staff have developed Funding Guidelines to help these agencies use their appropriations in a way that reduces greenhouse gases, furthers the purposes of Assembly Bill 32 (AB 32, Chapter 488, Statutes of 2006), maximizes benefits to disadvantaged communities, and meets the other statutory requirements.

ARB staff will present the written proposed Funding Guidelines at the meeting. 
