The Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) will conduct a public meeting at the time and place noted below to consider Truck Field Enforcement Activities and New Screening Technology for High Emitting Vehicles.

This item may be considered at a one-day meeting of the Board, which will commence at 9:00 a.m., April 27, 2017. Please consult the agenda for the meeting, which will be available at least 10 days before April 27, 2017.

Background

ARB collects emissions information for research and enforcement. ARB is developing a new system, called the Portable Emissions AcQuisition System (PEAQS), which measures emissions as cars or trucks pass sensors. Staff has developed a prototype system and it will be used to collect information to better understand emissions from cars and trucks and to help prioritize high emitting vehicles and fleets for enforcement.

PEAQS is equipped with an Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) system, which is used to convert pictures of license plates to text data and can be cross referenced to vehicle registration information. All of this information once collected is confidential. ARB has drafted its ALPR usage and privacy policy to ensure ALPR information remains secure consistent with state law.

Proposed

ARB staff will present a draft privacy and usage policy at the meeting. Copies of the policy may be obtained from ARB's Public Information Office, 1001 I Street, First Floor, Environmental Services Center, Sacramento, California, 95814, by April 17, 2017.


