NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING TO PROVIDE AN UPDATE ON DISCUSSIONS WITH THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS CONCERNING ITS 2035 REGIONAL GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSION REDUCTION TARGET

The Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) will conduct a public meeting at the time and place noted below to hear an update on discussions with the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) regarding SCAG's regional greenhouse gas (GHG) reduction target for 2035.

This item will be considered at a one-day meeting of the Board, which will commence at 9:00 a.m., February 24, 2011. Please consult the agenda for the meeting, which will be available at least 10 days before February 24, 2011, to determine the order of agenda items.

California State law (Senate Bill 375 (SB 375), Statutes of 2008) requires ARB to set regional targets for the purpose of reducing GHG emissions from passenger vehicles, for 2020 and 2035. Once a region has a plan in place to achieve the GHG targets, SB 375 provides for a streamlined regulatory review for certain types of development projects consistent with that plan's implementation. The targets apply to the regions in the State covered by the 18 Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs).

At its September 23, 2010 meeting, the Board directed staff to hold discussions with SCAG on the need to secure additional funding resources, tools, and other collaborative efforts, and to provide an update of these discussions at their February 2011 public meeting.

Interested members of the public may present comments orally or in writing at the meeting or may submit their comments by postal mail or by electronic submittal before

the meeting. To be considered by the Board, written comments not physically submitted at the meeting must be received <u>no later than 12:00 noon</u>, **February 23, 2011**. All comments should be addressed to the following:
