

## Meeting Summary

The Reactivity Research Advisory Committee (RRAC) met on April 13, to discuss several VOC reactivity-related topics. Over 35 participants attended the meeting, including several ARB staff from RD, SSD, and PTSD and representatives from U.S. EPA, air districts, academy, and coatings industry. Richard Corey made introductory remarks and Eileen McCauley facilitated the meeting. Dr. William Carter of the University of California, Riverside gave an update on three ARB sponsored projects (architectural coatings reactivity project, pesticide reactivity project, and new SAPRC99 mechanism development). Monique Davis and Jim Nyarady (SSD) discussed the status of several architectural coatings related activities (reactivity analysis, 2005 architectural coatings survey, and other coatings research projects). Other updates included consumer products (Carla Takemoto, SSD), U.S. EPA's status on the aerosol coatings regulation and the Advanced Notice of Proposed Rulemaking for future VOC policy (Stan Tong, U.S. EPA region 9), and VOC exemptions (Dongmin Luo, RD).
