After reading the California Air Resource Board, report, I became somewhat disturbed on the contents of the 26 page document. My name is Carl Rose; I am respiratory Therapist/HVAC Technologist. My thirty years working as a Respiratory Therapist, 18 years HVAC, I feel that my work and right has been violated. Some ten plus years, I started working on indoor air quality research. I had written to agencies such as the State Department of Health on developing a profile on indoor air and how it is affecting person of all walks of life. I have applied for grants and other funding to obtain the very information in this report.

Yes, I see names of persons who have contributed to this report, but I do not see my name in any part of this document. In my effort to obtain funding, I have written some of the same comments that I have noticed in the document. The only exception to the indoor air hazards mentioned in this memorandum is solutions and continuous monitoring seeking out both cancer triggers and asthma triggers. The use of indoor air filtering system for eliminating indoor toxins. The only indoor air filtering to my knowledge is the Defender; it is a system that has been FDA approved. The use of air handlers, for elimination, was not included in that report.
