

Accessing Ca. State Library's Online Resources

The California State Library provides access to a number of online resources including the Academic Complete, Masterfile, and Greenfile journal databases from the Ebsco company. The Ebsco journal databases are primarily indices containing complete bibliographic citations and abstracts, but full-text of articles is available for some titles, including science journals such as Environment, Environmental Toxicology & Chemistry, Journal of Environmental Education, and Scientific American. Cal/EPA staff can access California State Library online resources from their office PCs at this link - <http://www.library.ca.gov/services/online-resources.html> .

Staff can also access these online resources away from the office after obtaining a State Library borrower's card and PIN number. The PIN will be your password for accessing the journal databases and other online resources. The Ebsco journal databases now have an interface specifically for mobile devices such as Blackberrys and iPhones. From your mobile device, go to the [EBSCO Host Selection Page](#) and select EHOST Mobile (javascript must be enabled). The new EBSCO*host* application is tailor-made for the smaller screens of mobile devices.
