<i>CCI Program</i>	<i>Description</i>	<i>Administering Agency</i>
Sustainable Agricultural Lands Conservation Program	Funds strategic investments that prevent at-risk agricultural lands from conversion	Strategic Growth Council
Urban & Community Forestry	Optimize the benefits of trees & vegetation, including improving parks, trails, recreation areas, urban settings to increase value of outdoor experiences and opportunities for physical activity to improve public health	CAL FIRE
Forest Health Grants	Funds and implements projects to proactively restore forest health in order to reduce greenhouse gases, to protect upper watersheds where the state's water supply originates, to promote the long-term storage of carbon in forest trees and soils, and minimize the loss of forest carbon from large, intense wildfires.	CAL FIRE
Low-Income Weatherization Program	Install energy efficiency measures, rooftop solar systems, solar hot water heater systems and weatherization measures in low-income households in disadvantaged communities to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and save energy	Department of Community Services and Development

Wetlands and Watershed Restoration Programs	Fund restoration and enhancement of wetlands and mountain meadow ecosystems	CA Dept. of Fish and Wildlife
Healthy Soils Program	Provides incentives for on-farm management practices that build soil carbon	California Department of Food and Agriculture
State Water Efficiency and Enhancement Program	Provides incentives for irrigation systems, pump improvements, and fuel conversions that reduce greenhouse gases and save water on California agricultural operations	California Department of Food and Agriculture
