



- Focus on WUI with 60% of Fuels \$ FY03+
  - FY03 target of 50% of WUI \$ via Contract (FY04 50% of all Fuels \$) with preference over doing work with contractors vs. the federal workforce.
  - WUI projects should target the communities at greatest risk from wildland fire where the communities are actively involved ( \$ ), working with state & local partners.
  - Non WUI treatments should focus on CC 2 & 3 in Fire Regimes I, II or III with highest risk reduction potential.


