

OUTDOOR RESIDENTIAL WASTE BURNING INFORMATION

KERN COUNTY

Kern County falls into two separate air districts with different rules and regulations. The map below roughly outlines the boundary between them.



Burning residential waste outdoors is NOT allowed in western Kern County within the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District.

Within the Eastern Kern Air Pollution Control District, temporary exemption areas **might** be in the following Zip Code Tabulation Areas (ZCTAs), but only where there are no prior prohibitions.

- 93255
- 93505 (outside the boundaries of incorporated place, California City)
- 93519
- 93554

Temporary exemptions **might** be permitted in extremely low population density areas with no ZCTA assignment, but only where there are no prior prohibitions.
