**Public Workshop to Discuss the
Proposed Airborne Toxic Control Measure
for Emissions of Chlorinated Toxic Air Contaminants
from Automotive Maintenance and Repair Activities**

The Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) staff will hold a public workshop in Diamond Bar, California, to discuss the Staff Report: Initial Statement of Reasons (ISOR) for the Proposed Airborne Toxic Control Measure (ATCM) for Emissions of Chlorinated Toxic Air Contaminants from Automotive Maintenance and Repair Activities. The Board will also hold a public hearing on April 27, 2000 in San Diego, California, to consider approval of the proposed ATCM. We will mail the Board hearing notice, for the San Diego public hearing, separately on March 10, 2000.

At the workshop, we will discuss the background of this assessment, the tools used to gather information, and the specific requirements that we are proposing to reduce emissions. The enclosed fact sheet presents a background and overview of the proposed ATCM. The text of the ISOR and the proposed ATCM text will be available from the ARB home page at <http://www.arb.ca.gov/regact/amr/amr.htm> by March 10, 2000.
