To accommodate stakeholders in the northern California region, we will be conducting an additional stakeholder workgroup meeting to discuss the evaluation of the Air Resources Board's (ARB) Airborne Toxic Control Measure (ATCM) for Chrome Plating and Chromic Acid Anodizing. This workgroup meeting is in addition to the workgroup meeting to be held in El Monte, California, on November 22, 2002. The same information will be presented at each meeting. We are undertaking this evaluation to ensure the ATCM continues to provide maximum public health protection.
