



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

- 1. The above does not include the 78 listings for NAF/ULEF Exemptions in North America. This would add another 39 tests per year on average for North America.
- Testing load is based on 4 quarterly tests per mill listing.
- 3. Total listings are based globally for these TPCs.
- 4. It is not established whether there is sufficient reserve TPC testing capacity to adequately cover any significant increase in testing demand.



TPC Testing Capacity - Globally

- Globally, 852 mill/products listed as Phase 2 plus another 143 listed as NAF/ULEF exempt. Total annual TPC testing requirement = 3,480
 - Total number of **active** TPCs = 30
- Inclusion of potentially several thousands of laminators to those already covered under the CARB regulation would exceed the existing capacity of TPCs and their testing capabilities.
