

- **RICE NESHAP**

- The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued a final rule that will reduce emissions of hazardous air pollutants from both compression ignited and spark ignited stationary reciprocating internal combustion engines.

- **Internal Combustion Engine NSPS**

- The New Source Performance Standards (NSPS) and are found in 40 CFR Part 60 subpart IIII and JJJJ. These NSPS apply to new, modified and reconstructed stationary internal combustion engines.
