Certification of Dresser/Wayne 390Dx/GQU Series Dispenser

You requested certification of the Dresser Industries/Wayne Division V390Dx/GQU dispenser. The x in the model number indicates options not related to vapor recovery, and may represent the numerals 1 through 6.

This multi-product dispenser is similar to the currently certified Vista dispensers except that there is only one hose and nozzle per side. There is a switching valve which connects this dispensing apparatus to the appropriate product supply line. The vapor recovery piping is the same as the currently certified models.

As required by the Air Resources Board certification and test procedures, you requested the approval of the Division of Occupational Health and Safety, the Office of the State Fire Marshal and the Department of Food and Agriculture, Division of Measurement Standards. The necessary approvals have been obtained from these agencies.

I find that the use of this dispenser will not adversely affect vapor recovery systems on which it may be installed. Therefore, the Dresser/Wayne G390Dx/GQU dispenser is certified for use with Phase II gasoline vapor recovery systems.
