Certification of Southwest Series 4000 Dispenser


You requested California Air Resources Board (CARB) certification of the Southwest Energy Control Systems Series 4000 motor fuel dispenser. The 4000 series includes Models 4020 and 4040 and is represented by Exhibit 10 of Executive Order G-70-52-AM.

A test was conducted to verify that the vapor lines are not subject to liquid blockage or excessive backpressure, conditions which adversely affect vapor recovery systems. Test results were satisfactory.

As required by the Air Resources Board certification procedures, you requested the approval of the Division of Occupational Safety and Health, the Office of the State Fire Marshal and the Department of Food and Agriculture, Division of Measurement Standards. The necessary approvals have been obtained from these agencies.

I find that the Series 4000 dispenser as defined above will not adversely affect vapor recovery systems on which they may be installed. Therefore, the Southwest Series 4000 dispenser is certified for use with Phase II gasoline vapor recovery systems.
