
Certification of OPW 66CI Breakaway

You have requested Air Resources Board certification of the OPW 66CI inverted coaxial vapor recovery breakaway. The OPW 66CI breakaway is manufactured by Catlow as model AV200, and was certified by the Air Resources Board on April 07, 1993.

The Air Resources Board requires the approval of the Division of Occupational Health and Safety, the Office of the State Fire Marshal and the Department of Food and Agriculture, Division of Measurement Standards. Confirmation was received that the Catlow model AV200 inverted coaxial vapor recovery breakaway was acceptable and that there was no objection to the certification of this equipment.

Based on the fact that the OPW 66CI is the same breakaway which was certified as the Catlow AV200 breakaway, I find that the use of the OPW 66CI breakaway will not adversely affect the performance of the Gilbarco VaporVac system (Executive Order #G-70-150). Therefore, the OPW 66CI inverted coaxial vapor recovery breakaway is approved for use with Gilbarco VaporVac system (Executive Order #G-70-150).
