Certification of VST B125-18 and VST B125 Breakaway


You have requested Air Resources Board certification of the VST B125-18 and VST B125 coaxial vapor recovery breakaways. The VST B125-18 and VST B125 breakaways are manufactured by OPW as model OPW 66-C and OPW 66-CL respectively. The OPW 66-C breakaway was certified by the Air Resources Board (ARB) on May 29, 1993 and the OPW 66-CL breakaway was certified by the ARB on August 2, 1991.

The Air Resources Board requires the approval of the Division of Occupational Health and Safety, the Office of the State Fire Marshal and the Department of Food and Agriculture, Division of Measurement Standards. Confirmation was received that OPW 66-C and OPW 66-CL vapor recovery breakaways were acceptable and that there was no objection to the certification of this equipment.

Based on the fact that the VSTB125-18 is the same breakaway which was certified as the OPW 66-C breakaway and the VST125 is the same breakaway which was certified as the OPW 66-CL, I find that the use of the VSTB125-18 or the VST125 breakaway will not adversely affect the performance of the Phase II gasoline vapor recovery systems in California.
