
Approval of M. Carder Model ABV34 Coaxial Breakaway Coupling

You requested California Air Resources Board (CARB) approval of the M. Carder Model ABV34 coaxial breakaway coupling.

As required by the Air Resources Board certification procedures, you requested the approval of the Division of Occupational Safety and Health, the Office of the State Fire Marshal and the Department of Food and Agriculture, Division of Measurement Standards. The necessary approvals have been obtained from these agencies.

I find that the use of the Model ABV34 breakaways will not adversely affect the performance of vapor recovery equipment. Therefore, the M. Carder Model ABV34 coaxial breakaway couplings are certified for use on approved systems listed in the current revision of Executive Order G-70-52.
