You requested California Air Resources Board (CARB) certification of the various Phase I Pemco products listed below:

As required by the certification Procedures for Gasoline Vapor Recovery Systems at Service Stations, the approvals of the three State agencies is a precondition to certification by the Air Resources Board. The appropriate letters of approval have been obtained from these agencies. I find that the Pemco drop tube, fuel adaptor, fuel cap, vapor recovery adaptor and vapor cap when installed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, will not adversely affect the performance of vapor recovery systems on which they are installed. Therefore, the Pemco drop tube, fuel adaptor, fuel cap, vapor recovery adaptor and vapor cap are certified for use with Phase I type vapor recovery systems.
