

Installation of Dayco 7246 Flex-Ever Ultimate VR Hose

This letter is in response to your March 25 letter which you requested a "reverse" installation of the Dayco Flex-Ever Ultimate VR whip hose. The installation would be for use on systems configured to Exhibit 9 of Executive Order G-70-52-AM, which you have referred to as the "curly Q" configuration. This would place the end of the whip hose which is marked "nozzle" at the dispenser side and the other end at the breakaway. For this hose, the installation will have no adverse impacts on the vapor recovery performance of the system and is acceptable. The figure below illustrates a typical installation.
