Vapor Recovery Certification and Compliance Test Procedures Workshop

The California Air Resources Board (CARB) is holding a workshop to solicit public comments on new vapor recovery certification test procedures, modifications of existing certification test procedures, and new vapor recovery test procedures that can be used by the ARB and districts for compliance determination of in-use vapor recovery systems.

Existing certification test procedures proposed for modification include TP-201.4, Determination of Dynamic Pressure Performance of Vapor Recovery Systems of Dispensing Facilities and TP-201.6, Determination of Liquid Removal of Vapor Recovery Systems of Dispensing Facilities. New certification test procedures proposed for adoption include TP-201.1C, Static Torque of Rotatable Phase I adaptors and TP-201.1D, Pressure Integrity of Drop Tube/Drain Valve Assembly. In addition, we are also proposing compliance test procedures that are used for determining compliance with in-use performance standards or specifications.
