Application for Certification Testing of Vapor Recovery Systems

Certified Phase I and Phase II vapor recovery systems operate together to form a complete system for emissions control at gasoline dispensing facilities. Per CP-201, the Air Resources Board (ARB) requires that all Phase II EVR systems be evaluated on a Phase I system during certification testing to show the compatibility of the Phase II system with the Phase I system.

The applicant understands and agrees to certification testing of Phase I and Phase II EVR systems as conditioned below:

Concurrent testing of Phase I and Phase II EVR systems:

- 1) Failure of the Phase I system will result in termination of certification testing as a testing failure for both Phase I and Phase II systems.
- 2) Failure of the Phase II system will result in termination of certification testing as a testing failure for only the Phase II system.
- 3) Failures for which the cause is not clearly attributable to Phase I or Phase II will result in termination of certification testing as a testing failure for both Phase I and Phase II systems.

Advisory for concurrent testing: Concurrent testing subjects the Phase II system applicant to the greatest risk of certification testing failure. Testing termination may have adverse financial impacts for the applicant and these impacts should be considered prior to initiating concurrent testing of Phase I and Phase II systems.

Testing of Phase II system with a certified Phase I EVR system:

- 1) Failure of the Phase I EVR system will result in termination of certification testing as a testing failure for the Phase II system.
- 2) Failure of the Phase II system will result in termination of certification testing as a testing failure for only the Phase II system.
- 3) Failures for which the cause is not clearly attributable to Phase I or Phase II will result in termination of certification testing as a testing failure for the Phase II system.

The undersigned is authorized to bind the applicant and hereby acknowledges and accepts the risk of certification testing as conditioned above.
