NOTICE OF WORKSHOP

TO DISCUSS ENHANCED VAPOR RECOVERY (EVR) FOR ABOVEGROUND STORAGE TANKS (AST)

In 2008, the California Air Resources Board (ARB) adopted new regulations for ASTs used to store gasoline. These standards are known as EVR and are expected to reduce air contaminants by two tons per year, when fully implemented. EVR for ASTs consists of two modules – Standing Loss Control (SLC) and Phase I. SLC requirements became effective for all ASTs greater than 250 gallons on April 1, 2013, while Phase I requirements will become effective for all tanks greater than 550 gallons on July 1, 2014.

In order to assist facilities in complying with the July 1, 2014, deadline, the San Diego Air Pollution Control District (District) and ARB will be presenting a workshop on the upcoming Phase I requirements.

Please be advised that you must obtain written authority from the District before starting construction or any modifications to your AST. Although the District has implemented an over-the-counter process for issuing Authorities to Construct, please plan accordingly and start the process as soon as possible. **Also be advised that construction must be successfully completed no later than July 1, 2014.**
