SUBJECT: PUBLIC WORKSHOP TO DISCUSS PROPOSED 2014 ENHANCED VAPOR RECOVERY REGULATORY AMENDMENTS

The California Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) staff invites you to participate in a public workshop to discuss proposed amendments to Enhanced Vapor Recovery (EVR) regulations. The proposed regulatory amendments address existing requirements for Aboveground Storage Tanks (AST) and a new standard for Enhanced Conventional Nozzles (ECO Nozzles) to be used for fleet fueling operations.

The workshops will be held in three locations as indicated below; each workshop will cover the same topics and staff will make the same presentation.

In March and April of 2014, ARB staff conducted a series of workshops to discuss the AST EVR Regulatory Advisory and proposed ECO Nozzle standards, and to solicit feedback on those topics that could be incorporated into regulatory amendments that would be presented to the Board for consideration at the November 2014 Board meeting. ARB staff has considered feedback provided at those workshops, and has drafted proposed regulations for public review and comment. Those proposed regulations and supporting documentation will be the topic of these workshops.

California Environmental Protection Agency

At the March 2014 public workshops, ARB staff indicated that in November 2014 the Board would also consider adoption of proposed regulations to address in-station diagnostic (ISD) overpressure alarms and enhancements to the existing ISD system (also known as second generation ISD). Consideration of these two items by the Board has been delayed until the summer of 2015 to allow staff additional time to work with stakeholders in assessing potential solutions. This workshop will therefore not include a discussion of regulatory proposals for these two items although staff intends to provide an informational update.

Each workshop will consist of a one-hour presentation by ARB staff, followed by a question and answer period. The presentation will include:


- Overview of the Proposed Regulatory Amendments for AST and ECO Nozzle
- Staff Estimates of Cost Savings and Emission Impacts
- Outline of the Rulemaking Process
- Update on Overpressure Alarm Assessment and Second Generation ISD
