ARB is required to identify and list defects in vapor recovery equipment that substantially impair the effectiveness of a vapor recovery system to collect vehicle gasoline refueling emissions (Health and Safety Code Section 41960.2 (c)(1)). This list is referred to as the VRED List. Each listed defect results in the generation of excess smog-forming reactive organic gases and hydrocarbon emissions during vehicle refueling. At least once every three years, ARB is required to review the VRED List at a workshop to determine if updates are necessary. The VRED List was last amended on June 11, 2012.

At the workshop, ARB staff will provide a short presentation, followed by a question-and-answer period. ARB staff will discuss proposed changes and solicit feedback. 
