## PUBLIC WORKSHOP TO DISCUSS ENHANCED VAPOR RECOVERY CERTIFICATION AND TEST PROCEDURES FOR ABOVE GROUND STORAGE TANKS

Dear Sir or Madam:

The Air Resources Board (ARB) is developing enhanced vapor recovery (EVR) regulations for gasoline dispensing facilities using aboveground storage tanks (ASTs). EVR will provide additional emission reductions by increasing the stringency of performance standards and specifications for AST vapor recovery systems. The workshop will present the proposed standards, specifications, and procedures required for certification and testing of EVR vapor recovery systems for ASTs. The ARB invites your participation. The proposed AST EVR regulations are scheduled to be considered by ARB in spring of 2007. The workshop details are as follows.
