Dear Mr. Smith:

We are reissuing this letter due to a typographical error in a prior letter sent to you dated October 8, 2009. The October 8, 2009 letter should have referenced your email dated September 1, 2009 in lieu of September 1, 2008. To recap, in your email dated September 1, 2009, you described an issue regarding the usage of the term "i.e." in Exhibit 2, page 2 of Executive Order VR-205. You requested to change the term "i.e." to "e.g." to allow installing the Hirt indicator panel in other various locations. Using the term "e.g." would be consistent with language used in other Phase II Executive Orders for in-station diagnostic alarms.

We agree with your request. The verbiage "(i.e., cash register)" as currently written in item 4, Exhibit 2, section entitled "Hirt VCS 100 Thermal Oxidizer," of Executive Orders VR-205, VR-207, and VR-208, will be revised to read "(e.g., cash register)."
