To All Vapor Recovery Stakeholders:

EXECUTIVE ORDER G-70-215: MODIFICATION OF OPERATIVE AND EFFECTIVE DATES FOR ENHANCED VAPOR RECOVERY (EVR) PHASE II AND IN-STATION DIAGNOSTICS (ISD) ON GASOLINE DISPENSING FACILITIES (GDF) WITH BULK PLANTS

The enclosed Executive Order will extend the Phase II EVR and ISD deadline to April 1, 2015, for only GDFs where the underground storage system also serves as a bulk plant. This extension is necessary because there are no certified Phase II EVR and ISD systems for bulk plant GDFs. In 2008, the Executive Officer extended the Phase II EVR compliance date to April 1, 2011, for these bulk GDFs for the same reason.

Section 2.4.4 of CP-201 allows the Executive Officer to modify operative and effective dates of performance standards and specifications when no Phase II system, meeting such standards and specifications, has been certified. The enclosed Executive Order is applicable only to those GDFs that serve as bulk plants and provides an extension to the deadline for those bulk plant GDFs that are required to be equipped with ISD. The revised deadlines are summarized in Table 1.

**Table 1 – Revised Deadlines for Phase II EVR and ISD
For GDFs with Bulk Plants**

	GDF that is also a Bulk Plant
Required to Have Phase II EVR	April 1, 2015
Required to Have In-Station Diagnostics	
Dispenses > 600,000 Gal/Yr	April 1, 2015
