Dear Mr. Nelson:

In a letter dated April 29, 2011, Franklin Fueling Systems (FFS) requested a review of a modification to the Healy 795 Reconnection Clamp Jaw used to reconnect either the 8701VV or 807 breakaways that are part of the FFS/Healy Phase II EVR Certifications (VR-201 and VR-202 Executive Orders).

The modification to the clamp involves extending the jaws over the bar of the clamp to improve strength during clamping, increase tool life and also lower the chance of tool damage from dropping. Another modification is to use an etching process to identify the new tool as well as provide a date code on the product for product traceability.


