The California Air Resources Board (ARB) staff is holding a vapor recovery workshop to solicit comments on modifications to the existing certification and test procedures.

The time and place for the workshop are as follows:

At the October 18, 2005 Vapor Recovery workshop, ARB staff presented proposed changes to CP-201, *Vapor Recovery Certification Procedure*, D-200, *Definitions for Vapor Recovery Procedures*, and test procedures TP-201.2G, *Bend Radius Determination for Underground Storage Tank Vapor Return Piping*, and TP-201.2I, *Test Procedure for In-Station Diagnostic Systems*. Staff also proposed a new test procedure that will be used to conduct certification testing of pressure/vacuum (P/V) vent valves, TP-201.1E CERT, *Leak Rate and Cracking Pressure of Pressure/Vacuum Vent Valves*. Changes were also proposed to the process for updating the Title 17 "defect" (Vapor Recovery Equipment Defect, VRED) list.

Based on the comments received from the October 18, 2005 workshop, staff further revised the above documents. At the February 16, 2005 workshop, staff will present an overview of the revised documents. The workshop will include an open public comment period. Copies of all draft regulatory documents will be posted on the web page on or after February 1, 2006. To be considered written comments must be submitted by no later than February 21, 2006. The

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
workshop agenda and staff presentations will be posted on the web page no earlier than February 10, 2006.
