Subject: Public Workshop to Discuss Overpressure Alarms Associated with Phase II Enhanced Vapor Recovery Systems

The California Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) invites you to participate in a public workshop to discuss recent findings and potential solutions to address overpressure occurring at gasoline dispensing facilities (GDF) equipped with Phase II Enhanced Vapor Recovery and In-Station Diagnostic (ISD) systems. The workshop will be held in two locations as indicated in the table below. Each workshop will cover the same topics. Due to technical difficulties, the Sacramento workshop will no longer be available via webcast. These workshops build upon information previously released in March of 2014.

- Studies conducted
- Key findings
- Options under consideration
- Next steps

Additional workshops will be scheduled in the spring of 2016 where interested parties will have an opportunity to review and provide comments on proposed regulatory amendments. Proposed regulatory changes will be formally presented to the Board for consideration at a Board Hearing currently scheduled for mid-2016.
